RE: UPRR Planned Service Outage on I-5 Corridor, Beginning June 9, 2007

Dear Valued Customer,

Beginning June 9, 2007, the Union Pacific will undergo a 3-day planned service outage on the I-5 corridor (between California and Oregon/Washington) to perform an upgrade on the Dorris Tunnel as part of its ongoing effort to become double-stack capable in this lane. Dorris, California is at the north end of the Butte Valley in Siskiyou County, which stretches north to the California/Oregon state line. During the period, 4,500 feet of track will be lowered.

UPRR will continue to accept reservations and freight at involved terminals during this period.

Friday June 8:

ZLCBR runs as normal (last train through prior to closure)

ZLCSE annuls

ZBRLC annuls

Saturday June 9:

ZLCBR annuls

ZBRLC annuls

Sunday June 10:

IOASE annuls (see below for Mon special run)

ZLCBR annuls

Monday June 11:

ZLCSE runs as normal

ZBRLC runs as normal

IOASE – run special

Tuesday June 12:

Resume normal operation for all intermodal trains
