

Preparation for Hurricane Ike Includes Alternative Intermodal Route Between Jacksonville, FL and San Juan

Hurricane Ike is tracking across the Gulf of Mexico and its projected landfall is expected to hit the eastern coast of Texas or southern Louisiana Saturday, September 13, around 5:30 a.m. An alternative to using vessel service between Houston, TX and San Juan, Puerto Rico, as Stacktrain customers you can route intermodal freight to Jacksonville, FL by utilizing our integrated land/water service between Jacksonville, FL and San Juan, Puerto Rico on Trailer Bridge's state of the art vessels.

We will manage all land and ocean activities from booking to delivery, including optional Shipper Export Declaration documentation. Freight will travel the entire journey in Stacktrain's 53' 107" steel containers, eliminating transloading costs in Jacksonville (Trailer Bridge does not support 53' 110" containers/chassis). With this land/water service you will receive a single point of contact, an all-inclusive rate quote, full visibility of the entire journey, and one consolidated invoice.
