

Service for 53' Containers Between Seattle and Chicago will be Handled at New Tacoma South Terminal, Beginning January 30, 2009

Dear Valued Customer:

Just to remind you, Pacer service for 53' containers on UPRR between Seattle and Chicago and beyond Chicago will be handled at UPRR's new Tacoma South Intermodal Terminal (TacSim) effective on the days and times listed below.

If you haven't done so, please make note of the following transitions:

- As of January 30, 2009, all Westbound containers ingated at CSX Northeast origins will be destined to TacSim
- As of February 2, 2009, all Westbound containers ingated at UP Chicago Global 1 will be destined to TacSim
- As of 0700 February 9, 2009, all Eastbound containers should be tendered to TacSim

Also, please remember that Pacer does not offer 48' service into Seattle or Tacoma.

You should tender billing showing TACOMA or TacSim as the origin/destination effective on the above dates. (Pacer and UPRR will automatically convert billing for 30 days).
