HAZ MAT SURCHARGE

Dear Pacer Stacktrain Customer:

Effective May 1, 2002, Pacer Stacktrain is expanding the (\$80) surcharge to include domestic shipments of hazardous materials. Last year, the (\$80) surcharge was applied to international shipments of hazardous materials effective June 1, 2001.

The (\$80) surcharge on domestic shipments will apply on all routes with all underlying carriers. This (\$80) surcharge will apply to all intermodal equipment types and sizes. Implementation of this change will NOT eliminate the need for specific pricing documents on hazardous materials, which are specified as “Restricted and/or Prohibited Articles.”

The haz-mat surcharge does not alter the rules and policies concerning the shipment of restricted articles. Hazardous materials specified as “Restricted and/or Prohibited Articles” in UP Exempt Circular 20, Item 220 and in the Pacer Stacktrain Information Directory will not be accepted for transportation unless the shipper has made special arrangements with Pacer Stacktrain for acceptance and agreed to

special rate authorities. The hazardous material shipments will automatically be assessed the surcharge.

The (\$80) per shipment haz-mat surcharge will be assessed in addition to all applicable freight charges and will appear as a separate line item on invoices sent to customers.
