RE: CN Union Rail Strike

The CN Railroad and the Canadian Auto Workers (CAW) - it's largest union representing approximately 5,000 shopcraft, clerical and intermodal yard employees, were unable to reach agreement on a new contract by last night's midnight deadline. As a result, the CAW began picketing early this morning.

As reported earlier, the CN states it will attempt to use management personnel to keep CN intermodal ramps operational as best possible, however, the CAW picket lines will most likely disrupt normal yard operations which could result in delays to intermodal traffic moving on the CN network.

Pacer Stacktrain will advise at a later time regarding plans for freight currently moving on the Union Pacific Railroad with a final destination of Toronto or Montreal that has not yet interchanged to the CN.
