RE: CN Union Rail Strike – 2nd Update

The CN Railroad and the Canadian Auto Workers (CAW) - it's largest union representing approximately 5,000 shopcraft, clerical and intermodal yard employees, were unable to reach agreement on a new contract by last night's midnight deadline. As a result, the CAW began picketing early this morning.

As reported earlier, the CN states it will attempt to use management personnel to keep CN intermodal ramps operational as best possible, however, the CAW picket lines will most likely disrupt normal yard operations which could result in significant delays to intermodal traffic moving on the CN network.

Given the uncertainty of when this labor action will be settled, we now suggest customers refrain from billing additional freight to CN points. Please contact your Customer Service representative if you would like access to your Canadian destined freight held in Chicago.
