**Re: Pacer Stacktrain July 4, 2006 Holiday Schedule**

Dear Valued Customer:

In observance of the Independence Day Holiday, Pacer Stacktrain services with a scheduled cut-off of Tuesday, July 4, 2006 will not operate. Our primary underlying rail carriers, Union Pacific and CSX, have published specific terminal holiday operating hours, indicating that many rail terminals supporting the Pacer Stacktrain network will be closed on July 4th. Please contact the railroads for specific ramp hours of operation. Pacer Stacktrain will observe normal operating hours on Saturday July 1st, Sunday July 2nd and Monday July 3rd. Normal operations will return on Wednesday July 5th. Gate Reservations for Wednesday July 5th will need to be made by 9:30 am PST on July 3rd. Pacer Stacktrain will provide service on July 4th to monitor Southbound and Northbound automotive trains in Mexico.

Volume tendered to the Pacer Stacktrain network prior to July 4th will continue to operate through to destination with approximately an 8-12 hour delay as the Union Pacific, CSX and other U.S. rail carriers minimize rail network operations so that crew members may observe the Holiday. Those services with scheduled arrival and availability on July 4th will be delayed 24 hours at arrival terminal due to the Holiday operating schedule and the build-up of containers inside the rail terminals.

If you have questions regarding the July 4th Holiday Operating Plan, do not hesitate to contact your local Pacer Customer Support or Sales Representative regarding specific terminals or Pacer Stacktrain Services. Please note that Pacer Stacktrain Customer Support and Equipment Reservations will not have people staffed on Tuesday, July 4th. However, please remember you will be able to track loads by using our new Interactive Voice Response (IVR) system.
