Re: URGENT - CSX South Kearny Terminal will close the gate for empty returns commencing at 1:00 pm EST, June 29

Dear Valued Customer:

A major storm crossed the Northeastern States on Tuesday and Wednesday dumping from five to seven inches of rain in some areas, causing flooding and damage. The worst of the flooding is expected on Thursday as the waterways in eastern Pennsylvania and upstate New York that feed into the Delaware River begin to crest. The rising Delaware River prompted New Jersey Governor Jon S. Corzine to declare a limited state of emergency in four counties for June 29th.

CSX Railroad reports that service adjustments and delays for all traffic moving in this region should be expected. Please plan accordingly. In particular, CSX has have experienced a track washout along its main line between East Fonda, NY and East Utica, NY. This has caused an annulment of westbound trains from the CSXI intermodal facility in South Kearny, NJ. As a result the CSX South Kearny Terminal has become severely congested. To control the congestion, CSX has announced that it will close the gate for empty returns to its South Kearny Terminal commencing at 1:00 pm EST, June 29th. We ask our customers to advise their draymen of this temporary situation.

We will advise you when the service at the CSX South Kearny Terminal returns to regular operations. For further information, please check with the CSX Railroad.
